Children's Vocational Successes
 - ◆ Son Andrew Fiddes holds a B.Mus (*Sydney University*), and a B.Mus (Jazz) (*Sydney Conservatorium*). He performs on trumpet and composes in the medium of jazz. He is a member of The Australian Army Band, Sydney. He has released two CD albums with his groups *Survival of the Fiddes* and *Livewire* to much critical acclaim.
 - ◆ Daughters Samantha (then 13) and Jaclyn (then 11) were selected from auditions of some 2500 children to play the lead role of Mary, as principal and understudy (later made alternate performer) respectively, in the 1995/96 Australian production of the Broadway hit musical, *The Secret Garden*. This co-production by John Frost / The Lyric Opera of Queensland / Queensland Performing Arts Trust toured Brisbane, Sydney and Melbourne. The cast included Anthony Warlow, Marina Prior, Philip Quast and June Salter. Samantha has contributed to a cast recording of show highlights for CD and cassette release. In 1994 Samantha and Jaclyn shared the role of Little Cosette in the Opera Hunter production of *Les Miserables*.
 - ◆ Samantha achieved the 2002 CONDA (City of Newcastle Drama Award) for Best Professional Actress in Carl Caulfield's *Confusion of Tongues* & has since performed on stage in Newcastle & Sydney as well as directing and/or choreographing for productions including the 2007 Opera Hunter production of *CATS*.
 - ◆ As a dancer, at age 15 Jaclyn achieved the McDonald Performing Arts Challenge Senior Scholarship, the RAD Solo Seal and a full scholarship to the Royal Ballet School, London.
